## NCCF Offers Fall Weekend at Cape Lookout

**Ocean, NC** – Come experience a glorious fall weekend at Cape Lookout National Seashore. Fish for speckled trout and red drum, hunt for seashells and learn about major coastal environmental issues.

The N.C. Coastal Federation and the Cape Lookout Environmental Education Center have teamed up to offer a weekend at the Cape, November 10-12. Participants will spend two nights in cozy cabins at the education center's remodeled fish camp south of the Cape Lookout Lighthouse. Federation staff members will lead educational activities and excursions out into the national seashore.

"We'll tailor activities to the interests of those attending," explained Frank Tursi, the Federation's Cape Lookout COASTKEEPER® and one of outing's leaders. "We'll fish, take beach walks, look for seashells, whatever people want to do. The idea is to educate people about the major environmental issues facing our coast while having some fun."

The cost for the three days and two nights is \$175 a person, which includes accommodations, food, fishing tackle and bait, and boat transportation to the education center.
