Come Listen to Tales of Shipwrecks and Pirates

WRIGHTSVILLE BEACH - Nathan Henry, the assistant state archaeologist, will talk about ancient mariners and pirates who sailed in North Carolina's coastal waters at the N.C. Coastal Federation's Fred and Alice Stanback Education Center in Wrightsville Beach on Wednesday, Nov. 12, from 7:00 to 8:30 p.m.

Henry, who works for the N.C. Department of Cultural Affairs, will take the audience on an underwater archaeology trip to the past. The coast of North Carolina is known as the Graveyard of the Atlantic because of the treacherous shoals and dynamic barrier islands that make for difficult navigation. Henry has worked intensely on the Queen Anne's Revenge and logged hundreds of hours in search of artifacts from the ship captained by the infamous pirate Blackbeard.

"As a boater, I find it interesting to see the tools used by pirates and explorers to travel around our diverse coastal waters here in North Carolina," said Coastal Advocate Mike Giles. "We are excited to have Nathan share his knowledge and tales of our coastal history."
