Staff of the N.C. Coastal Federation and the pier will offer this immersive experience June 24-27 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. each day. Participants will be engaging in indoor and outdoor activities as well as visiting various environmental resource sites along the Outer Banks. They can plan on getting their feet wet and hands dirty as they lend a hand on a variety of coastal projects from marsh grass plantings and oyster restoration activities to monitoring species at a variety of habitats in the community.

This opportunity is open to teenagers, ages 13 through 16, and is geared towards giving them hands-on learning experiences while also highlighting a variety of science-oriented careers.

Take this chance to get involved with some projects that are invaluable for preserving critical coastal habitats and water quality and log some community service hours while you're at it.
