## Honoring Decades of Coastal Leadership

When Olivia Holding joined the Coastal Federation's Board of Directors in 1996, she saw immense potential in the young organization. At the time, the Federation was only 14 years old and rooted in the unincorporated community of Ocean, NC. **"I saw so much potential in the Coastal Federation's collaborative approach to coastal issues," Olivia recalls. "I knew it needed to grow to serve our entire coast. I encouraged Todd Miller, the Federation's founder, to think big. His vision has transformed that ambition into real, lasting change for our coast."** 

**Today, that shared vision has created an extraordinary opportunity.** The Coastal Federation has broken ground on a new Center for Coastal Protection and Restoration in Carteret County, a place dedicated to uniting communities in protecting North Carolina's coastal environment. Located on Bogue Sound between Morehead City and Swansboro, this 10-acre campus will become a hub for innovative educational programs, hands-on engagement, and community-driven solutions for coastal health and resilience. This center will not only serve as the Federation's headquarters but also as a place for the community to connect, learn, and act to protect our coast.

This fall, in honor of Todd Miller's remarkable 42 years of leadership, the Holding Family has launched a \$100,000 Matching Challenge to support the Center's completion. Every dollar pledged by December 31, 2024, will be matched dollar-fordollar, up to \$100,000. This challenge offers a unique opportunity to bring this community resource to life, ensuring that Todd's legacy of coastal stewardship and community engagement will continue to inspire and empower future generations.

- New programs for groups like Scouts and the Boys & Girls Clubs, birding tours, volunteer opportunities, and more.


